Conditions

Classification

This competition is open to Club Compete Swim England/Swim Wales/Scottish Swimming members with a swimming classification **S1-15 & S64** who are aged 10 and above on 31/12/24. Guest entries will only be accepted from:

Swimmers on the Physical Classification waiting list (classification 99)

Swimmers with an VIRTUS or SportExcel UK classification application submitted.

There <u>may</u> be a physical classification team present at this competition. Swimmers wishing to be considered for a classification must enter before the **5**th **August 2024.**

Swimmers from outside the host region

Swimmers from outside the North East Region are welcome to enter this event but should entries exceed the capacity of the pool, entries from the North East and the North West Regions will be prioritized.





Events

Individual events will be made up of swimmers with similar entry times, irrespective of their age or classification. This is in order to make the events more competitive and increases the opportunity for swimmers to gain fast times. It is important therefore that accurate times are submitted for all events. If no time is completed, then the swimmer will be placed in the slowest heat.

Epilepsy

Swimmers with epilepsy should ensure that the lifeguards are made aware of this before each of their races. A responsible adult who knows the swimmers condition should accompany them. This person must act as a "spotter" on the poolside while the swimmer is in the water.

Refreshments

It is advised that athletes bring their own food and drinks. Drinks will be made available for officials.

Medals

Medals will be awarded to the first three places in each event for male and female, using British Para-Swimming Points (S1-14). Separate medals will be awarded to S15 swimmers.

The minus 1 rule will be used to award medals:

Where there are only three swimmers in an event, only the top two placed swimmers will receive medals Where there are two swimmers, only the winner will receive a medal

Where there is only one swimmer, they will receive a medal if they swim faster than their entry time

Poolside Access

Only team managers, coaches and chaperones that have pool side passes will have access to the poolside. Classes S1-5 and S11 are eligible for chaperone passes to gain access to poolside, to give assistance to swimmers. Passes are free of charge and should be requested at the time of entry. These can be collected on the day of competition. If a swimmer goes through classification and is awarded an A for assistance a pool side pass will be issued on the day.

Entry fees

There will be a £9.50 entry fee per event. The entry fees should be paid when submitting the entry form.
