Accreditation

All coaches, chaperones and team staff must have a valid accreditation to access the event. Accreditation is non-transferable and must be worn at all times when accessing athlete areas inside the venue.

It is the clubs' responsibility to ensure that individuals who will be Coaches or Team Managers during any of the sessions are listed on the Club Personnel Report and have the appropriate qualifications in place:

- Valid and in Date DBS with Barred List Check
- Valid and in Date Safeguarding with the Swim England Membership Department
- Minimum Level 2 Coaching Qualification or Team Manager Module 1

Coaches, team managers and chaperones requiring access to poolside must purchase a poolside accreditation pass in advance of the event. Clubs/teams must follow the guidance as set out in the current version of [Wavepower](#) and individuals may only act in one role at the event and fulfil the following criteria:

Chaperones must only be in attendance on a 1:1 support basis for an athlete as per the [Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy](#). In the instance of para-swimmers, Tappers or Disability Support personnel would act in a 1:1 capacity with a specific athlete.

Accreditation will be emailed to you in PDF format to print and will need to be brought to the event.

Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones will be required to sign into every session and provide evidence of their Coaches/Team Manager Pass.

Poolside Pass Fee is **£10.00 per weekend**

Note: Poolside accreditation passes are only valid for entry to poolside and not valid for the spectator gallery, any person within the spectator gallery with a poolside pass will be asked to leave.

There will be no refunds for withdrawals for this reason once entries have been submitted.

The stream/video will be controlled by Swim England North West, and as the meet organiser we reserve the right to remove the stream from the internet should we feel necessary. This will be at the discretion of Swim England North West.

NB: Due to the limited spectator capacity at Liverpool Aquatics Centre, spectators will be limited to 1 person per swimmer and tickets will need to be purchased online.

Competition Refund Policy

Swim England North West have created the following policy regarding what will and won't be refunded following a Swim England North West Regional Competition or Event.

All criteria outlined below must be submitted within 5 days of the completion of the event.

Following this 5-day period, and subject to all criteria outlined below being adhered to refunds will be processed within 28 days.

Rejection from Events

If entries have been rejected by the championship manager where conditions were adhered to but rejection is based on time constraints, then refunds will be automatically processed for each rejected event following the completion of the competition.

Rejection due to non-compliance of conditions

Any entries rejected due to non-compliance of competition conditions will not be refunded. By entering any Swim England North West Event or Competition, individuals are committed to adhering to all conditions and policies outlined by Swim England North West.

Withdrawal due to exception circumstances (e.g. Medical or Injury)

Individuals who have withdrawn from events due to either a medical reason or injury – refund will be considered by application and submission of appropriate evidence (e.g. note from doctor or note from physio).

Withdrawing from the event must be completed prior to the event/session in which the individual is due to compete. Evidence can be submitted at the time of withdrawal by uploading information to the link. Any failure to withdraw or notification of withdrawal received later than the event withdrawal cut off time will result in no refund being processed.

Following the completion of the event, please submit details within 5 days and email events@swimnorthwest.org

In line with the Swim England North West Data Protection policy, once the refund has been processed, documents relating to an individual's medical information will be destroyed.

Withdrawal

For all withdrawals which would not be considered under the heading above, refunds will not be processed.

Exceptions to the above may be considered by the Event Management Group but these will be dealt with on a case by case basis. Withdrawals prior to the event can be sent to events@swimnorthwest.org
